



EVOLUTION OF PANAJI

Panaji, the capital of Goa State, is a small but charming city on the left bank of the Mandavi River with beautiful, red-roofed houses, built in the Latin style. It also boasts of many modern houses, well laid-out gardens, statues and avenues.

The etymology of the name, Panaji, can be traced to a copper plate inscription of the Kadamba King, Tribhuvanamalla of 1107 A.D., where the place has been referred to as *Panjani Khali*. In Sanskrit *Panja* means a small boat, while *Khali* means a canal or a creek. Thus the name may mean a locality on the bank of a creek navigable by small craft.

During the period of Muslim rule, the town was remarkable for the fort of Adil Shah in which the secretariat is now housed. It was from this fort that the Muslim ruler offered stiff resistance to the Portuguese under Afonso de Albuquerque when the latter first invaded Goa.

The Portuguese captured Goa in November 1510 and Panaji was made a military station. During the administration of Dom Manuel de Portugal e Castro (1827-35), Panaji became a place of some prominence. In 1843, it was formally declared by a Royal Decree to be the capital of Portuguese India and continued to be the seat of the Governor till Goa, along with Daman and Diu, was liberated by Indian forces in December 1961, after 451 years of Portuguese colonial rule.
