Various Schemes of GoI For Girl Child

- **SUKANYA SAMRIDDHI YOJANA** (The girl has the right to have an account in her name, and her family will be just joint holders. By PM (MoW&CD))
- **BETI BACHAO BETI PADHAO** (It also prevents abortions and supports the education of the girls) (joint initiative of MoWCD, MoHFW & MoE)
- **CBSE UDAAN SCHEME** (It is for the girls who had science in their 11th and 12th class and It also looks into the annual income of the family)
- **NATIONAL EDUCATION POLICY (NEP)-2020** (GOI Has introduced "Gender Inclusion Fund" for targeting the development of girl child so as to provide quality and equitable education for all girls.) by MoE
- **'KNOWLEDGE INVOLVEMENT IN RESEARCH ADVANCEMENT THROUGH NURTURING (KIRAN)'** (This scheme is primarily aimed to bring gender parity in science & technology sector by inducting more women talent in R & D domain through various programmes.) by MoST
- Craftsman Training Scheme and Crafts Instructor Training Scheme (In national skill training institutes, few seats sanctioned for girls) By MoSD
- Many more.

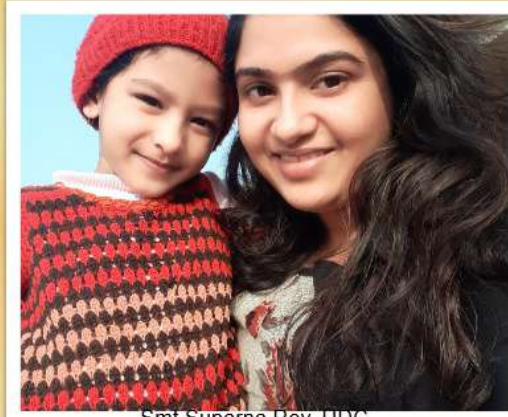

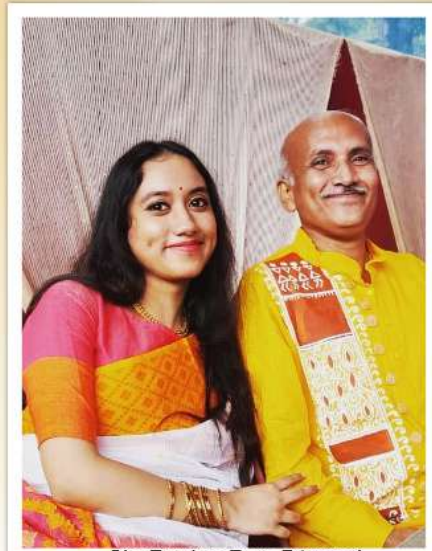
