Subject: Regarding amendments in Survey of India (Group 'A') Service Rules, 1989 related to eligibility conditions for promotion to SAG level-reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the subject cited above and to say that it has been decided to carry out the necessary amendment in Survey of India Group "A" Service Rules, 1989 related to changing the eligibility conditions for promotion to SAG (PB 4 Grade Pay Rs. 10000/-) level posts i.e. Additional Surveyor General (Both Civil and Defence Stream) as per provisions of DoPT OM No. 14017/61/2008-Estt.(RR)/Pt. dated 18.01.2011.

2. The details of proposed amendments in Schedule I (Civilian Stream) and Schedule III (Defence Stream) of Survey of India (Group 'A') Service Rules, 1989 are as follows:

Row 7 of Schedule I and Schedule III pertaining to Column 2 (Senior Administrative Grade)	Existing provision	Proposed provision	Remarks
In Case of recruitment by promotion/deputation/transfer, grade from which promotion/deputation/transfer to be made	8 years' regular service in the Junior Administrative Grade (including service if any, in the non-functional Selection grade) or 17 years' regular service in Group 'A' Service out of which at least 4 years regular service should be in the Junior Administrative Grade	Officers in the grade of Superintending Engineer and equivalent (PB-4 Grade Pay of Rs. 8700/-) with 3 years regular service in the grade or officers in the grade of Superintending Engineer/equivalent with 17 years regular service in Group A posts in the service out of which at least 1 year of regular service should be in the PB-4 Grade Pay of Rs. 8700/-."	The proposed changes are as per provisions of DoPT OM No. AB.14017/61/2008-Estt.(RR)/Pt. dated 18.01.2011.


